Travel Information

If you travel by plane, you will arrive at Brussels Airport Zaventem BRU, which is located in the area of Zaventem and in short distance to the city center. You can get from the airport to the center in about 30 minutes by train, bus or cab. General information can be found on:

Train

Brussels Airport has its own train station on Level -1, below the terminal. From here, a train runs six times per hour from Brussels Airport - Zaventem railway station to Brussel-Noord, Brussel-Centraal and Brussel-Zuid stations. The average journey time from Brussels Airport to Brussel-Centraal is 17 minutes.

A 'standaardbiljet' - as it is called in Belgium (Flemish) - for a single trip costs 8.90 €, this includes the diabolito surcharge of 5.40 €. You can find more information on the Belgian Railway Company website: <https://www.belgiantrain.be/en/home>.

Bus

In addition to the train, you can also travel by bus between Brussels Airport and the city center. From Monday to Friday, you can take bus line 12 until 8 pm. After 20h, on weekends and holidays, you can take bus line 21. These "Airport Lines" buses depart from Level 0 (Platform C). Both lines run between Brussels Airport and the Brussels-Luxembourg railway station, located in the center of the European quarter. If you want to get to the center of Brussels, you can get off at the Brussel-Schuman stop and change to the metro (M1 and M5). The bus journey between the airport and Brussel-Schuman takes about 30 minutes with bus lines 12 and 21, the buses depart every 10-20 minutes.

A one-way ticket costs 4.50 € at the red-blue GO ticket machine on platform C and 6.00 € on the bus. A ticket is 60 minutes long for the bus, metro and tram. You can also buy a relatively cheap JUMP ticket for 24h (7.50 €), 48h (14 €) or 72h (18 €). For this you need a MOBIB card worth 5.00 €.
