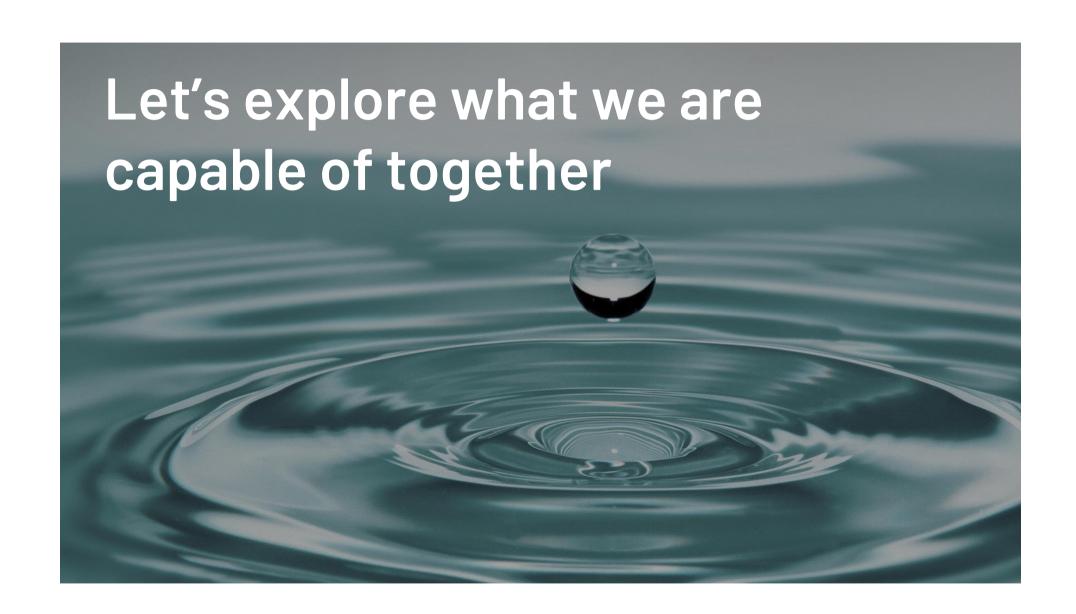












Co-Development Concept is a structured process designed for joint development of new tourism products and services or improvement of existing ones

Module 4: Pitch your idea

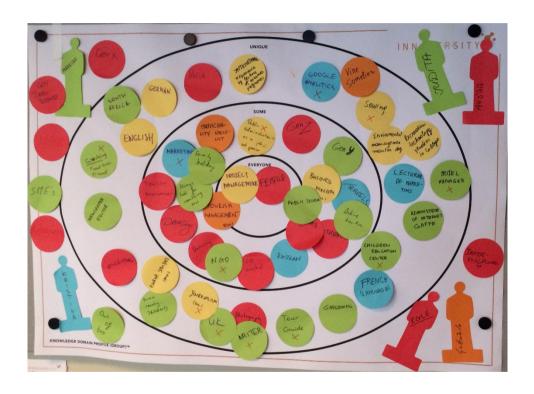
Sharpen and asses the value proposition (product or service).

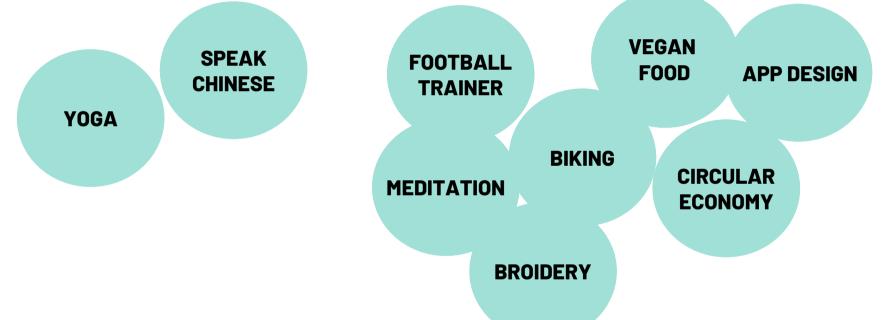

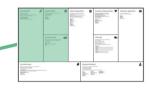

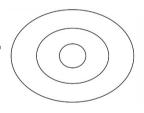
MODULE 1 COLLABORATIVE INNOVATION

Explore your capabilities for products and services when combining the resources and competences of the group.













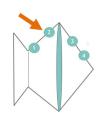

Understand the different needs and wishes of various customer segments and prioritize which segments to target.

















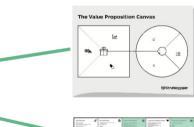

Make the first business model for this offer













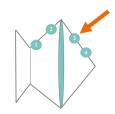

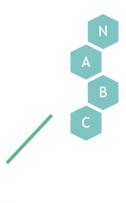


MODULE 4 PITCH AND SHARPEN

Complete your business model with the new insights made on basis of the pitch and feedback on this.







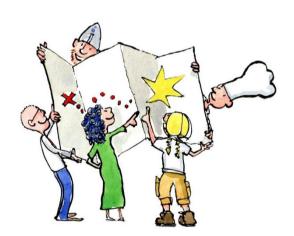






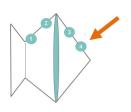
